Examination Regulations January 21st 2016 for Master's Degree Program in Computational Sciences at Freie Universität Berlin

§ 13 Graduation

- (1) The prerequisites for the conferral of a university degree is that the requisite accomplishments as stated in §§ 7 and 9 of these regulations have been completed.
- (2) The university degree will not be awarded if the student has not completed his or her academic records for the same degree program, for the same subject, or for a module which is comparable or identical to one of the modules studied in the Master's degree program and is still be taken into account for determining the final grade,
- or if he or she has failed to pass examinations, or if he or she still has outstanding examinations at another institution of higher education.
- (3) The application for determining the conferral of the university degree shall be accompanied by evidence that the prerequisites as detailed in paragraph 1 exist, and by an assurance that none of the cases in paragraph 2 apply to the applicant. The relevant examining board will make a decision on the application.
- (4) On the basis of the passed examination, the university degree Master of Science (M.Sc.) will be awarded. The student will receive certificates (Appendices 3 and 4), as well as a Diploma supplement (German and English). Furthermore, a supplement to the certificate (Transcript) detailing individual modules and their components will also be issued. Upon application, additional English versions of certificates will be issued.
